C.) The Charter for Compassion: a multi-media exploration Jan. 20, 27, Feb. 3, 10, 17 & 24

facilitated by Cheryll Wallace, Director of Religious Education, On February 28, 2008, theologian Karen Armstrong won the TED Prize and made a wish: for help in creating, launching and propagating a Charter for Compassion. Since that day, thousands of people have contributed to the process so that on November 12, 2009 the Charter was unveiled to the world. The second UU Principle encourages UUs to promote justice, equity and compassion in human relations. What is compassion and how can we cultivate it in our lives? We will explore this topic using a variety of media including video lecture, poetry, music, film, personal stories and discussion.
